





Joan was a three decade member of the Farmers' Union Horse Company for the Recovery of Stolen Horses and Detecting the Thieves, Organized A.D. 1834. The FUHC held a yearly parade and horse show at Heyser Field, Valley Forge Road, Fairview Village, Pa. where she worked in the entry tent. Joan rented a barn and pasture at a farm on Merrybrook Road in Worcester. She kept daughter Rebecca's Welsh Arab, Oakie Doak there, her own Standard bred, "Herbie", and rescue ponies Honeybee and Merrybrook Jingles.

ANN LAUBER

Ann loved equine sports of all kinds and attended and competed in many horse shows. She enjoyed working with young people at summer camps and teaching horse driving. She was a member of the Farmers Union Horse Company, the American Driving Society, the American Horse Show Association, and the Pennsylvania Horse Show Association. Ann was owner of Haydown Stables In Worcester along with friend and business partner, Eleanor Jonathan, where they brought lots of children to the show for many years.





CONESTOGA WAGON





Conestoga wagons are a distinctive horse drawn freight wagon that were built from the mid to late 18th century by the Mennonite settlers in the Conestoga valley. Designed to haul loads over rough roads, the wagon could carry up to 6 tons of freight. The distinctive shape of the bowed floor curving upward on each end prevented the load from shifting go up or down hills. The bowed canvas top was soaked in linseed oil for waterproofing. The wagons were pulled by teams of 4 or 6 large horses that could cover an average of 15 miles a day. There wasn't a seat for the teamster, (driver) instead he would walk along side the team, or rode the left horse nearest the wagon or sat on the "lazy board" the could be pulled out from under the left side of the wagon

It took several days to travel from Lancaster to Philadelphia, and nearly a month to travel to Pittsburgh from Philadelphia. The wagon that Farmers Union owns was used to haul goods from Philadelphia to Pittsburgh and hauled back 6 tons of coal.

Conestoga wagons are huge by wagon standards. They were not the covered wagons of the westward expansion. Those prairie schooners were farm wagons with lower sides and shorter length with a bowed top. Lighter weight for the long distance.

Conestogas were restricted to roads, and roads were in the east. By the 1840's with the coming of trains and canals the wagons' importance diminished. But they were still the local freighter till the end of the 1800's and the invention of the truck.
